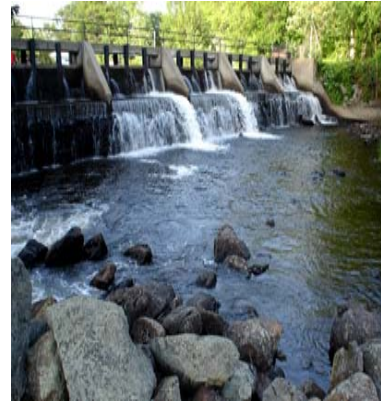

- ◆ Provide a cleaner environment for ourselves and our future generations

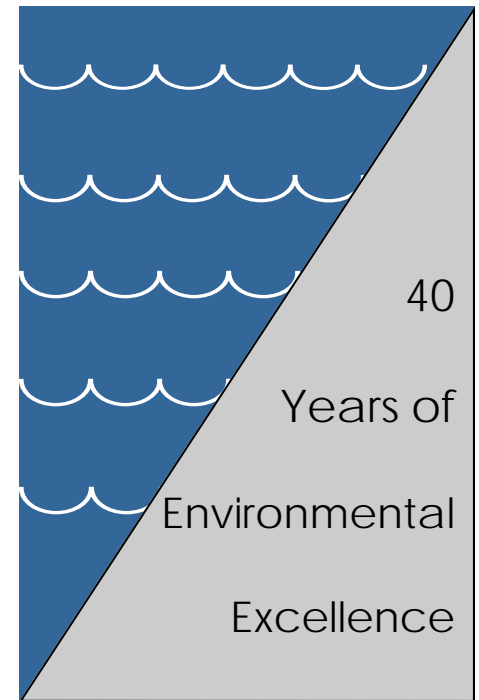
Who Are We?
